If you are going to hire and use a translator to translate documents that you want apostilled, authenticated, or legalized you can copy/paste, print out, and **attach along with your translated documents and a copy of the original document** that you got translated this Certificate of Translation document that has been approved to use by the Texas Secretary of State.
